Lone Ranger

In teams of three or four, each player plays their own ball. On a rotational basis one team member is the Lone Ranger. Record the Lone Ranger scores and the best ball from the other three for each hole. The lowest aggregate score wins one prize, then the lowest Lone Ranger score wins the other prize (can not be the same team).

The Red Ball Challenge

Each foursome entered is given a numbered Red Ball which must be played on every hole. The score of the Red Ball is recorded along with a score of one of the other three players for a total score (decided before the next tee). Each player must have at least two scores on the card along with two Red Balls. Scores must be marked as each hole is played, not at the end of the round. If the Red Ball is lost, the foursome is disqualified. Prizes for 1st place, 2nd place and 3rd place.

Chapman Alternate Shot

Most important: no player hits the same ball twice in a row. Both players tee off, then play a second shot, but hitting their partner's drive. The team then decides which ball to finish with, using alternate shot.

4-Man Mexican Scramble

All 4 hit their drive. Then use dice to randomly choose which drive you will use. Mark the ball. Everyone will play their next shot from the same spot, including on the green.
